

When Chas Collins steps on stage, it's easy to see why he debuted on CMT's Top 10 list. With his signature vocals and high energy stage show he delivers the full package. In two short years he has quickly become the most sought-after country rock artist in the state of Florida. An Entertainment coordinator of a recent venue said "He is one of the best performers I have ever seen." Hailing from New Orleans LA, Chas was born with music in his soul. After a visit to Nashville he recorded his first CD at Magic Tracks Studio. "They Wanna Hang a Bad Boy" was released in 2005. Being a native of the NOLA area, life took a turn as it did for many of its beloved sons when Katrina destroyed the city, but the strong willed performer was determined to follow his dream. With a couple changes of clothes and the money in his pocket he set his sight on Nashville. During his 17 year stint there he released two albums "They Wanna Hang A Bad Boy" and "That's What She Said." The latter of the two spawned a #9 single and music video on CMT beating out Miranda Lambert by a landslide who came in at #10.

Collin Raye, Brian White, just to name a few and has performed over 2600 shows in 43 states in his 18

year career . In 2019 Chas hosted and performed in Kornfield Friends, a spinoff from the hit show HeeHaw which included some of the original cast such as Buck Trent, Lulu Roman, Misty Rowe and Jana Jae in theaters around the country.

Chas has also written songs with some of Nashville's Top songwriters such as Lee Bogan (Joe Diffie), Keith Burns (Trick Pony), Bobby Fisher (Phil Vassar and Reba McEntire) and 2018 Country Music Songwriter Hall of Famer Byron Hill (Alabama and George Strait). Chas just recently release his newest Single "Something 'bout the Rain" and is preparing to shoot the music video as well as working in the studio too release 3 more singles this year.
